

MY ABC TOY BOX: SUGGESTIONS

VOWEL AND CONSONANT SOUND CHARTS: You can have fun singing My ABC Toy Box songs together! Try...

1. Using related reinforcing toys/items that match with the sound, storing them in a fun “toy box”
2. Pointing to the matching sound picture cue as you get ready to sing the verse for that sound
3. Saying the sound name as you point to the picture cue /matching item (i.e. sheep sound like “baa” ...”aaa”)
4. Starting the music, singing along, encouraging your child to sing too, pausing at the end of each verse to practice
5. Holding the fun item up near your face, as you sing along, so your child can “see” and “hear” how you are saying it
6. Encouraging your child to say the target "fun" sound/word independently, providing a model if needed
7. Giving your child a chance to play with the toy even if they aren't talking yet. Have fun playing and practicing together!
8. Using a mirror so your child can “see” how they are moving their mouth, “moving your mouth” as you practice together
9. Use slightly exaggerated mouth movements, volume and inflection, to emphasize the target sound /word
